

## Legion Baseball COVID Plan

Bolln Memorial Wood Bat Tournament

July 10-12, 2020

### Contract Tracing

1. All Teams, coaches, field crew, umpires and Rec Staff will have temperature checks one a day, recorded with COVID- response questions recorded and kept on file at the Rec Center Desk. Temps to be taken by Rec Center Staff.
2. Sunflower seeds will be allowed in the seating area, cups are available for used seeds. Sunflower seeds are NOT ALLOWED in the dugout.
3. Water – players need to bring their own water. Sharing of water containers is prohibited.
4. Converse County Health regulations do not require umpires to wear face coverings.
5. Social Distancing
  - a. Designated seating area marked by cones to allow for social distancing. Family members can sit together.
  - b. Dug-outs – teams will be reminded about safe social distancing practices in the dugouts and using face coverings when appropriate.
  - c. Teams should enter and exit the field at the gates of their designated dugouts.
  - d. Outside Concessions will be available. All concession personnel are required to wear face coverings and gloves (PPE) at all times. Patrons should stand 6 feet apart while waiting in line.
  - e. Bathrooms – players bathrooms are located behind 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout, patron bathrooms are located in the north west corner behind the blue shed out the fence at left field.
  - f. Bathrooms will be cleaned once a day.
  - g. The Rec Center is not available for public use. However, there is a dressing area for Umpires available inside the Rec Center.
  - h. Little League bathrooms will be available at Bearcat Stadium.
  - i. All bathrooms will have hand sanitizer available.
  - j. Picnic tables have been placed in designated areas and are six feet apart.
  - k. Parking in the left and center field is allowed by accessing Logsdon Lane/Bearcat Trail.
  - l. Face Masks will be available to anyone who wishes to wear them.
  - m. Hand sanitizer will be in each dugout, along with sanitization supplies for disinfecting helmets, bats and all baseball equipment.
  - n. Teams using the 3<sup>rd</sup> base dugout will warm up on the DPS playground and use the batting cage on the hill. Teams using the 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout will warm up on the little league fields and use the little league batting cages. DO NOT WALK ON THE NEW TRACK, THE FOOTBALL FIELD IS NOT AVAILABLE.
