NOTE- only one person per program should file the Form1's

30th **Deadline** for the Department Baseball Chairman to clear online Form 1's with the National office to be eligible for national tournaments

July 15th **Deadline** for baseball scholarship application submission to Department Headquarters.

29th Deadline for Department Chairman to certify State Champion to the National office and Regional tournament Director. Department Tournaments must be completed by 11:59pm

Note- deadline means it has to be received by that date.

9) 2023 Approved Rule Changes

There are no rule changes for the 2023 season. National is **NOT** recommending we use the enlarged bases or the pitch clock.

There is a new bat certification list that has been published by the NCAA that has incorporated both decertified and prohibited bats by color. Pease refer to the State website/Equipment/NCAA Playing Rules/Bat Information/ BBCOR Certified Bat

The State's position with guidelines for our coaches and umpires is in the process of being written and will be sent to you when it is completed.

Pitch Count- will be verified at home plate by the two head coaches and plate Umpire at least twice a game. Penalty for exceeding pitch count- both head coach and player are ejected from the game (National Rule). Knowingly violating this rule will incur an additional 2 game suspension for the first infraction, a ten (10) game suspension for the second infraction, and a permanent suspension from coaching Legion baseball for the third infraction.

The Ohtani rule will not be used in the State of Wyoming. Plate umpires will be enforcing the bat and pitch count rules.

10) Policy/Playing Proposals

The State received two proposals within the last 30 days. Any proposal to be considered for the next playing year, they must be received no later than September 30th of the current year. This will give the Board and committee time to review and respond to person/organization submitting the proposal.

- 1) A proposal was received from Luke Andrews for adding a second 15u classification to allow programs to be more competitive with their 13 year old players. After reviewing the proposal and talking with Luke, it was decided the current State rules allow the Head Coach the flexibility to provide this group competitive play within the respective program Adding a 5th State tournament, at this time, is not feasible.
- 2) A proposal was received from Kalin Hill to move away from the A district tournaments and replace them with a 3 game seeded playoff in order to qualify 4 teams from each district to the State tournament. There are some issues with this method when you have an 8 team conference and one team Is going to host the tournament. In a 7 team conference the host and #1 seed would receive a bye allowing the remaining teams to play for the final 2 spots. From a cost standpoint, this proposal may have some support going forward, but for the 2203 playing year, it will be tabled.

11) District Tournaments

The "A" division is separated into an East/West conference. The West conference, due to travel restrictions, will play home/away double headers within their quadrants to determine their seeding into the District tournament. The East conference will play a single double header against the other conference teams, based on a home and away, 2 year rotating, schedule. The top 4 teams from each tournament will advance to the State tournament and be seeded into the National, 8 team, double elimination tournament.

West District- Lovell July 19th 21st East District- Cheyenne July 19th -21st

13) 2023 State/Conference Alignment

AA- All AA teams are on one conference and will play a 7 inning double header with the other AA teams. This is a two year commitment. The conference will re-schedule at the end of the 2023 playing season. Conference teams are as follows;

State tournament rotation has been adjusted as follows

Tie Breaker Rules

- 1- Head to Head
- 2- Runs Allowed
- 3- Runs Scored
- 4- Coin Flip

Tie breaker rules have to be followed in order. Runs allowed and runs scored is the total number of all conference games.

Conference and State Games

NO re-entry and **NO** courtesy runner will be allowed during conference and state games. Run rule will be 10 runs after 5 innings

If you want to use re-entry and courtesy runners during regular season games, you will have to establish that at the plate meeting before each game.

13) LOGO

A new logo (see below) has been approved by the National office. They are encouraging all teams to start using the new logo, "as new opportunity presents itself", in 2023.



Update to the Logo- National has informed me that Logo has been put on hold. We are to continue using the crossed bat patch until further notice.

14) Umpires-

- All umpires will be paid direct.
 Local fees will be set by the individual program.
 - State rate is \$80 per game, plus mileage (.58 per mile) and per diem (\$30 per day) State tournament host are responsible for the cost of umpires, including motel rooms.
- Re-start our evaluation process. Gary will assign evaluators around the State. If hosting a tournament, please include one of the evaluators as an umpire
- Umpire State meeting 12/4 at 11am
- Umpire Clinic Douglas Middle School- February 5th- 10am- Cost \$80
- Plate umpire will assume the responsibility for rule enforcement on white bats and pitch count. This will be reported immediately to both the State UIC and Chairman.
- All game ejections shall be reported within 24 hours to the State UIC and Chairman.
