  - Jan 2<sup>st</sup> Online team registration begins
    - **15**<sup>th</sup> K&K Insurance website opens
  - March 1<sup>st</sup> Wyoming **DEADLINE** for insurance to be purchased.
    - **31**st Establishment of players' legal domicile (parents' domicile) and high school enrollment for grades 10, 11 and 12
  - **April 1st** Wyoming **DEADLINE** for Abuse Training Certificates and Background Checks to be completed and submitted
    - **15**<sup>th</sup> Report site and date of State AA and A state tournaments
  - May 1st Wyoming DEADLINE to register team applications and pay registration fees. Department late fee of \$200 will be charged until June 1st.

  - **July 15**<sup>th</sup> **Deadline** for baseball scholarship application submission to Department Headquarters.
    - **Aug 1st Deadline** for Department Chairman to certify State Champion to the National office and regional tournament Director. Department Tournaments must be completed by 11:59pm

Note- deadline means it has to be received by that date.

- 9) 2023 Approved Rule Changes
  - 1) Rule 2.C.4 Clarification Any player wo signs a professional contract will be declared ineligible for the remainder of the season and may be replaced on the National Form #1 by an eligible player.
  - **2)** Rule 6.E.1 Dual Roster For those American Legion Baseball programs that have affiliated senior and junior teams, any junior eligible Oplayer on the junior team roster may appear in an affiliated senior team game provided the total number of players in such senior game does not exceed 18.
  - 3) **Rule 10.17** Pitchers will get the win after 4 innings

All Conference nominations have to be complete by 7/15 voting complete by 7/19

B/C- These teams are set up in quadrants and play teams in their quadrant for . state tournament seeding. Alignment will be completed by January 15, 2024

All Form 1's, Form 2's, certifications and insurance have to be approved by the State Baseball Chairman or his designee or Tournament Director before the first game of any State Tournament.

Tie Breaker Rules

- 1- Head to Head
- 2- Runs Allowed
- 3- Runs Scored
- 4- Coin Flip

Tie breaker rules have to be followed in order. Runs allowed and runs scored is the total number of all conference games.

**NO** re-entry and **NO** courtesy runner will be allowed during conference and state tournaments

Run rule will be 10 runs after 5 innings

# 12) C Division Changes

Wyoming will allow drop 5 bats in this division The bats have to be USA Certified and should be marked to eliminate confusion Recommended fence length no longer than 315" for State Tournament

# 13) Umpires-

- All umpires will be paid direct.
- Local fees will be set by the individual program.
   State rate is \$80 per game, plus mileage (.58 per mile) and per diem (\$30 per day)
   State tournament host are responsible for the cost of umpires, including motel rooms.
- Rain outs
  - Mileage and 1 game fee if both games are rained out Mileage, per diem and one game fee if  $2^{nd}$  game is rained out prior to 4 inning, otherwise full pay
- Plate umpire will assume the responsibility for rule enforcement on white bats and pitch count. This will be reported immediately to both the State UIC and Chairman.
- All game ejections shall be reported within 24 hours to the State UIC and Chairman.
- Work with the park manager on lightning delays We will follow the WHSAA guidelines on lightning strikes- 6 miles- 30 min delay
- Home team insurance will cover injury to umpires (National directive)

We are currently working on a series of clinics for umpire training. Our thought is to hold a two day clinic that would be geared for younger umpires on day one and for our Legion umpires on day two.
